

Captain Dave "Uncle" McMahon

Capt. Dave McMahon was born in June of 1930, in East Hampton. He attended East Hampton High School and continued on to further his education at Kings Point Merchant Marine Academy.

Capt. Dave has spent his whole life in Montauk, marrying Marie Pitts in 1949. He and Marie had two daughters, who still reside locally. He has two grandchildren. Dave and Marie were married for 60 years, until Marie passed in March of this year.

Capt. Dave McMahon started mating for Capt. Gus Pitts, who was docked at Duryea's Dock in the 1950s. He worked with Gus until 1968, when he bought the boat and business and continued as Captain on the charter boat *Marie III* until 1987.

Dave specialized in inshore fishing, inventing the spreader rig along with Capt. Gus Pitts. This allowed the possibility of catching four different kinds of fish at one time. Dave's famous line when asked what he was catching was, "I've got one little bass and two little blues"; he always did the "DMT" on the way home (the "Dave McMahon Troll").

Dave is currently employed at Gosman's as a maintenance engineer.

A boat catching less than 4 species, no matter what the weight, will not beat a boat catching all four species, no matter what the weight. A boat which catches only 3 species will not win the Grand Slam, even if all the other boats only catch 2 species. (This only applies to the Recreation Division.)
